Submission and Presentation Overview

All authors are invited to submit a poster to present at the 2010 ESW National Conference hosted by Purdue University, October 7 – October 10, 2010 during the reverse career fair at the national conference. Project-related posters from students, college faculty, non-profits, government labs, and industry partners are encouraged or projects done by ESW teams or for graduate research are welcome for the poster session that is separate from the reverse career fair but held at the same time in the same location.

Poster Submissions

On the afternoon of October 8th, 2010, the conference will include a reverse career fair and a simultaneous poster session for students. The reverse career fair is for ESW students to present their project team work. The poster session is open to all attendees with projects not affiliated directly with an ESW chapter and a broader range of project topics.

In order for the presentation of a poster to take place at the conference, at least one author from each team must be registered for the conference. If the poster is for research done by one individual, that person must be present.

Themes

The 2010 ESW National Conference at Purdue University is an opportunity for students, faculty and industry partners to come together for constructive dialogue on this year's conference theme, "20/20 Vision: Focusing on Innovation in Sustainable Design".conference is focused on innovation in sustainable design now and for the future. We will be accepting posters from ESW chapters on their projects for the reverse career fair. For the poster

session we will be accepting posters from research or projects done by students or professionals outside of ESW chapters.

Poster Guidelines

ALL posters must be submitted no later than 11:59 PM September 23rd, 2010 for review by the Purdue ESW conference team. They must be in either PDF or Powerpoint format.
